Classes Begin

Classes begin Wednesday, October 3. Kindergarten through Grade 6 will meet at Centerville Elementary at 6:30pm. Grades 7-Confirmation meet at the Faith Formation Center at 6:30pm. EVERYONE is finished at 7:45pm. Please pick up younger kids first, then go to the Faith Formation Center if you have family in two places.

First Day of Class Arrival and Departure Procedure

For K-6th grade: please walk your children into Centerville Elementary and find their classroom. Children in K-6th grade will remain in their classroom until a parent or designated person comes to get them at 7:45pm. If parents do not arrive to pick up their child from the classroom by 7:50pm, the catechist will bring them to the cafeteria where they will wait until parent or designated person arrives to pick them up.

For 7th-10th grade: youth must enter the building upon arrival and remain in the building until parent or designated person comes to the classroom to pick them up.
