GUIDELINES FOR LECTORS - Parish Community Center

REQUIREMENTS:

- Come 15 minutes prior to Mass (Please be on time If you are not checked in 10 minutes before Mass begins you will be replaced)
- Yearly commitment as a Liturgical Minister and renew with annual training.

PREPARATION:

- Read over your scripture readings from the Source Book/Lector Workbook <u>prior to</u> coming to Mass
- Check in with the Sacristan upon arrival to be updated on any changes in the schedule or additional announcements.
- Review the information in the binder containing Introductions, Readings, for this days Mass and the Prayers of the Faithful on the ambo. (Ask the Sacristan or Priest how to pronounce names you are not familiar with)
- Check out the pronunciations of the Biblical names you don't know (www.
- Check your microphone to ensure it is working properly and adjust it so you are speaking into it

PROCEDURES:

- Several minutes before Mass begins make your way to the ambo and be seated and wait until the prelude song is finished
- After the prelude song is finished go to the ambo at the scheduled time for Mass to begin -
 - Stand at the ambo and greet everyone and proceed to read the Introductions and Announcements.
 - Stand while the priest and servers process in
 - Sing with the congregation the entrance song
- After the priest does the opening prayer you will approach the ambo and read the First Reading
- The congregation sings the responsorial psalm and you are seated during the singing
- After the Psalm is finished return to the ambo and read the Second Reading.
- **After you finish the Second Reading** return to your seat (Please sit close to the front so you can return quickly for the Prayers of the Faithful)
- If you are reading from the Lectionary, leave it as you found it on top of the ambo for the priest to use
- Return to your seat
- After the Homily
- Return to the ambo <u>during</u> the Creed at the words <u>"I believe in one holy catholic apostolic Church...."</u>
 (Be ready to read the Prayers of the Faithful at the conclusion of the Creed when Father introduces these intentions)
- Wait for Father's concluding prayer to the Prayers of the Faithful before returning to your seat

LECTOR TRAINING:

- Read over the scheduled scripture readings found in the Source Workbook for Lectors before you arrive for Mass
- Review any unfamiliar words for correct pronunciation and people's names in the announcements and the Mass intentions
- Practice reading <u>slowly</u> and pronounce words <u>clearly</u>
- Arrive at least 15 minutes before Mass
- Check your microphone and make sure that it is on it should remain on
